## BRITISH SKYDIVING SPECIFICATION FOR STATIC LINE DEPLOYMENT BAGS (TRADITIONAL EQUIPMENT) British skydiving Spec: SLDB 1

Bag body material not less than 5oz/sq.yd. close weave canvas, acrylic, or other material approved by British Skydiving Riggers' Subcommittee.

Webbing for main anchor point to be 1.75 inches wide, 3600 lbs breaking load. American type 8 or British WR 420A meets the requirement.

Support tape for line stowage loops; Type 2 – 600 lbs.

Line stowage loops; Type – 500 lbs.

## **BAG DESIGN**

Can be any size to suit requirements and canopies, and may be any of the following:

Split Bag with single full-length mouth lock.

Split Bag with small mouth lock for first line stowage and full mouth lock.

Solid Bag with full mouth lock.

Solid Bag with Centre Base tie beckets.

Solid Bag with Centre Base tie beckets and mouth lock.

## **NOTES**

- 1. All main support webbing on Centre Base tie bags must be a continuation of main support anchor point. (Side wall beckets N/A).
- 2. The breaking strain of the Centre Base tie should be between 80 lbs and 140 lbs.
- 3. Irvin Bag type DB2/4 meets the above specification requirements.
