TARGETED COACHING SUPPORT

The Elite Performance Committee (EPC) may offer funding for targeted coaching support to the winners* of the non- senior categories at British Skydiving National Championships**

A maximum of £600 may be offered per team, which is to be utilised for coaching fees only (ie not jumps, wind-tunnel time, entry fees, equipment etc).

In order to be eligible to apply for this support, teams must meet the following criteria.

Criteria

- 1. The team has won a non-senior category at a British Skydiving National Championships.
- 2. The team has competed at the subsequent British Skydiving National Championships (ie in the year immediately following their win) at a higher level and in the same discipline*** (eg a 4-way FS team could progress from Rookie to A, or A to AA, and an Accuracy team could progress from Intermediate to Senior).
- 3. The team must consist of the same members across both Championships, or if changes are made they must meet the allowable team line-up changes as set out on Form 299 ****

Application Process

- Step 1: The team must compete at a British Skydiving National Championship
- Step 2: The same team must compete in the same discipline at a higher level at the subsequent British Skydiving National Championship
- Step 3: The Team Captain must complete Form 300 and Form 143A and send them to the EPC Secretary compscoordinator@britishskydiving.org along with all relevant paid invoices/receipts *****
- * Only outright winners will be considered.
- ** Indoor Skydiving Competitions/championships are not British Skydiving Nationals competitions.
- *** Funding is not available for both Open and Female categories.
- **** Verification of team line-up may be sought from British Skydiving Officials attending the event and/or the entry form.
- ***** The offer of support will be subject to budget allocation and the EPC may from time- to-time withdraw this funding offer. Decisions will be made by the Committee and communicated to the team by the Technical Excellence Adviser and/or the EPC Secretary at the earliest opportunity. A team has the right to appeal the decision.

Invoices will be reimbursed within 30 days.
