The application for renewal must be signed by a Chief Instructor (CI) who must be satisfied that the applicant is current with skydiver dropping techniques, emergency procedures and relevant British Skydiving Operations Manual requirements. **If a renewal is not effected within two years of expiry, then a pilot must fulfil all the initial requirements for Authorisation.**
